Club Playing Kits

Often the central and most important part of a club's teamwear is the purchase of the team kit.

We leave no stone unturned to ensure that every aspect of your order is perfect and that all the options open to you are explored prior to your purchase.

Step 1 - Specifying your requirement

Initially we will discuss your requirement in depth to establish what are the best options available to you. This will include understanding the numbers of shirts, shorts & socks; the club colours; and discussing basic design ideas.

We will also learn about the level of Rugby being played, and the balance between moisture management, flexibility and longevity. We will also discuss your budget to ensure that you maximise the value return for your outlay.

Step 2—Designing the shirts

Once we have established the basic specification we will look to establish the actual material & design to be used.

Each of the manufacturers will have their own specific names for their materials but they are basically split into two main groups. These are the traditional *Poly Cotton* Rugby shirt & the moisture managed materials that are manufactured from Polyester/& nylon.

Once we have chosen the most appropriate material we will work with you to design the kits. We are able to offer you a computerised custom kit designer to enable you to decide on the designs or we can come back to you with design ideas.

At this stage we also need to discuss details like the embroidery of your club crest, placement of sponsors names and Numbering styles.

It will save on your budget if you are able to provide an electronic version of the embroidery and any sponsors' logo's.

Step 3— Providing the quotation

Now that we have all the details that we require we can provide you with a full quotation. Each part of the cost is itemised and delivery, VAT and any additional options will also be included.

We will clarify the exact material that will be used, and then your quotation can be sent by email, post or fax.

Step 4—Placing the order

Once you are entirely happy with quotation we will give you a final proof to sign off. This is your and our assurance that what you get is what you have ordered.

It is important to note that the exact tone of the colours selected won't always match those on the original diagrams although we always make every effort to replicate as accurately as possible.

You will be given an estimated delivery date and the delivery address will be confirmed. Normal delivery dates will be 6-8 weeks dependant on the time of year and the exact design chosen.

We would always advise that you allow a little leeway prior to the first day that the shirts need to be worn.

Step 5—Completion

The shirts will be checked by Club Rugby Teamwear for compliance prior to shipping to your delivery address.

We would ask you to check, where possible, that the delivery has been received completely & to your satisfaction within 48 hours of receipt so that any problems can be immediately highlighted and resolved.

Products designed to be either less baggy and easy to grab or with moisture management properties that reduce the dampness and weight of the product offer a competitive advantage.

Canterbury



As shirt suppliers to the Australian, Irish & Scottish National Teams and one of the most recognisable sporting brands on the planet Canterbury of New Zealand have quality and style as their hallmarks.

Despite being formed in New Zealand as long ago as the late 1880's they now supply more shirts in Europe than they do 'Down Under'.

There are three main material types for Canterbury; they are Tectex, Teamtech & Aquadry.

Tectex This Nylon/ Polycotton mixture was originally developed for the Super 12 teams & has continually evolved to what is now sold. Tectex fabric uses a technology that wicks sweat away from the body keeping the wearer dry and reducing the weight of the shirt in hot or wet conditions.

Teamtech The traditional Poly Cotton fabric which has proved a winner for clubs and International sides since 1904.

Aqua Dry Polyester These are the 'Rugby League style' jerseys which provide moisture management to keep the wearer dry & comfortable whether playing in hot or wet conditions. The designs are printed onto the jerseys meaning that absolutely any design is possible. The fabric also has soil releasing qualities even in excessively muddy conditions.

KooGa



Now established as one of the world's leading Rugby brands, it seems amazing to think that KooGa were only established in 1997.

As a dedicated Rugby only brand they have quickly become established as a leading player in the teamwear market and provide the kit for some of Britain's leading clubs, such as Harlequins, Northampton Saints & Neath Swansea Ospreys.

The different material options available are:

Microtech Soft feel, cotton spun acrylic material. Available in 350G and 400G weight options. Strong and Durable.

PolyCotton 50/50 Blend 320G traditionally knitted material, offers all the qualities of cotton with the strength and washing properties of polyester. Lightweight yet strong.

Evaporex Smooth finished polyester outer, with cotton liner produces a 300G technical fabric with superb comfort. Hydrophilic moisture transfer properties featuring new Sweat without wet technology to keep you cool and dry.

Polytech

The textured finish of this 300G 100% polyester thermal material produces a "body climate" environment, keeping you cool and comfortable. Again moisture transfer technology means you will benefit from the latest advances available to elite rugby athletes, as worn by National, Premier and Celtic league clubs.

Sublimated (Promax SM)

Samurai sublimated jerseys are made from the same Promax cooling fabric and come in the same two weights 280 g & 220 g. The design you choose is then printed on to the fabric, making this suitable for non cut and sew designs.

Protech This hard wearing, yet amazingly comfortable polycotton fabric has been much favoured in the Southern Hemisphere. These shirts are manufactured in 280g (leisure wear) & 360 g (match wear).

Protex—

Protex 280g shirts designed specifically for mini's and juniors give the feel of Cotton but all the advantages of a man made fabric. It is stronger than standard acrylics colour fast and shrink resistant.
